Notice is hereby given pursuant to Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, that the Board of Commissioners of Real County Emergency Services District No. 1 will meet in regular session, open to the public, at **5:30 P.M.**, on **Tuesday, June 16, 2026**, at 474 West Ranch Road 337, Leakey, Texas, 78873, at which time the following subjects will be discussed, considered, passed, or adopted:

1. Call Meeting to Order.
2. Citizens' Comments. At this time, any person may speak to the Board if they have filled out a Participation Form. Comments will be limited to three (3) minutes per person. No action will be taken on these items and no discussion will be had between the speakers(s) and members of the Board. The Board does retain the right to correct factual inaccuracies made by the speakers. If this item lasts longer than 30 minutes, then the balance of comments will continue as the last agenda item of the day. Members of the public may address the Board, for a maximum three (3) minutes per person on items on the agenda. Members of the public will be allowed to speak on an agenda item after comments on the item are called for by the presiding officer, but before Board discussion and consideration of the item.
3. Discuss and consider approval of regular meeting minutes for the May 19, 2026, regular meeting.
4. Discuss and consider action regarding District Treasurer's report, including:
 - a. Approval of monthly bills, invoices, and checks; and
 - b. Approval of financial report;
5. Approval of District's financial audit and filing audit with county, or request 30 day extension if needed.
6. Discuss and consider approval of annual reports from Frio Canyon EMS;
7. Discuss and consider approval of annual reports from Leakey VFD;
8. Receive monthly updates from service providers: Frio Canyon EMS and Leakey VFD;
9. Discuss and consider approval of the Real County Tax Assessor/Collector calculations for tax rate;
10. Discuss and consider approval of the RCESD1 preliminary budget for fiscal year 2026-2027;
11. Adoption of a tax planning calendar:
 - a. Discuss and consider adoption of the tax and budget planning calendar for 2026, authorize payment of tax process publications, and take any related action;
 - b. Schedule additional budget meetings/workshops as necessary.
 - c. Discuss and consider District website status, accessibility, and posting requirements and take any related action.
12. Discuss and consider District's next regular meeting day, time, and place.
13. Adjournment.
