1. Call Meeting to Order.
2. Citizens' Comments. At this time, any person may speak to the Board if they have filled out a Participation Form. Comments will be limited to three (3) minutes per person. No action will be taken on these items and no discussion will be had between the speakers(s) and members of the Board. The Board does retain the right to correct factual inaccuracies made by the speakers. If this item lasts longer than 30 minutes, then the balance of comments will continue as the last agenda item of the day.
3. Consider taking action regarding 2026-27 budget;
4. Discuss and consider taking action regarding 2026 tax rate, including:
 - a) establishing proposed tax rate;
 - b) taking record vote and scheduling public hearing;
 - c) authorizing expense and publication of "Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase" in Uvalde Leader News; and
 - d) acknowledging and approving posting of "Notice About 2026 Tax Rates" and "Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase" to home page of District website.
5. Discuss and consider District's next regular meeting day, time, and place.
6. Adjournment.
